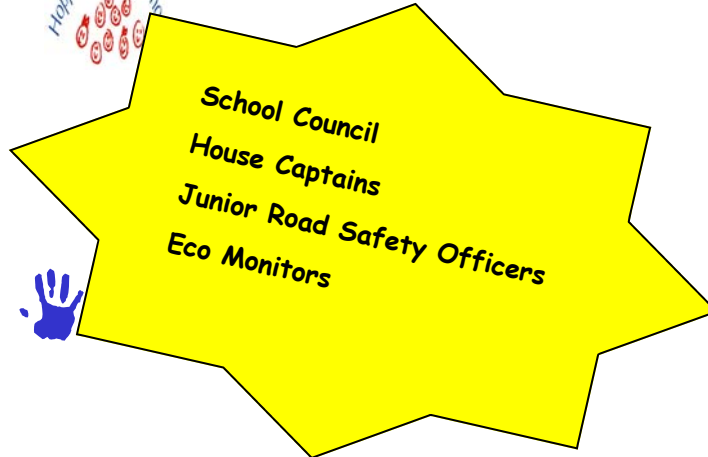
Reception and year 1 at 12.00
