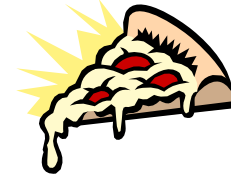

Pizza Fun!



This half term your child will be learning about:

- 🍷 How to investigate, sort and use materials
- 🍷 Italy and some famous buildings from this country.
- 🍷 How to send and receive emails.
- 🍷 Materials and how to weave fabrics.
- 🍷 Recognising coins and finding totals, mass, 3D shapes, position and direction, choosing and using appropriate number operations and mental strategies to solve a problem.
- 🍷 Ordering numbers to 50 and recognising all numbers to 100.
- 🍷 Forming all their upper and lower case letters correctly.
- 🍷 Understanding where full stops and capital letters need to go in more than one sentence.
- 🍷 Stories with familiar settings (parks, restaurants, forests) and looking at being able to give and carry out instructions (how to make a pizza).
- 🍷 How to handle food hygienically and make a pizza.

In order to make the learning fun and interesting for the children, they will study these areas through the connector, Tasty. In the classroom, we will have a pizza parlour where the children can use their imagination to take on the roles of waitresses, waiters, customers, chefs and restaurant managers. They will be able to practise adding up totals, recognising coins, giving change and forming numbers correctly. They will also be practising their letter formation as they take orders, allowing them to continue to develop into confident writers.



Little Chef's



During this topic, the children will experience making a variety of pizzas with different bread bases. They will taste a variety of different fruits, vegetables and meats (ham, pepperoni, salami). Please let us know if your child has any food allergies or is unable to eat certain foods. They will also be learning about food hygiene and how to use kitchen tools safely.



Helping your child at home

You can help continue your child's learning at home by:

- 🍷 Pointing out different numbers and seeing if the children can name them.
- 🍷 Letting children experience using money by helping them to add up smaller totals and pay using coins when out shopping.
- 🍷 Reading with them each day and playing word games. Looking for sounds and counting how many of the sounds are in the book. ee, oo, ai, sh, ch, th, ow,
- 🍷 Allowing the children to find different materials and textures within the home.
- 🍷 Tasting different fruits and vegetables.
- 🍷 Working on spelling words and number bonds.
